

## Jackie Chan: The Invincible Fighter

A dizzying, dazzling collection of early Jackie Chan fight scenes have been compiled in 95 action-packed minutes for "Jackie Chan: The Invincible Fighter." Nearly all the scenes come from films not widely seen by most audience, which makes the film both refreshing and historically informative. The selection of scenes and the chronological arrangement is also extremely well thought out. Students of Kung Fu will also probably enjoy the disc for its presentation of a diversity of styles, which Jackie varied throughout his career. Most of his more noteworthy Kung Fu, however, before he began more creative choreographing on his own, comes from these earlier films. A nice extra here, too, is a 6-minute interview with Jackie, conducted at the time of the "Rush Hour" press junket. Hearing Jackie's enthusiasm for the film's opening and his pride in the accomplishments of fellow Hong Kong émigrés -- including "Martial Law" star and childhood friend Sammo Hung -- is endearing.
